1. Technical evaluation of proposals:

The technical proposals received with the bid security amount, in the form mentioned in the invitation of bids issued on dated 02.07.2009, will only be considered for Technical evaluation and bids not accompanied by applicable minimum bid security, in appropriate form, will not be considered and summarily rejected. The criterion for technical evaluation of proposals is a reflection of consultant's expertise in similar works, financial strength and resourcefulness to take up such assignments. The consultant is required to submit a **Concept plan** for the accomplishment of targeted task along with technical proposal.

Technical proposal awarded with 70 or more Marks will only be considered successful as pre-qualified and considered further for financial evaluation. Financial offers of consultants whose technical proposal score is less than 70 Marks will not be opened and returned unopened.

2. Evaluation criteria for Technical proposal:

Client shall evaluate each technical proposal taking into account several criteria; (a) The consultant's relevant experience for the assignment, (b) the quality of the methodology proposed, (c) the qualifications of the key staff proposed (d) Transfer of knowledge. The proposed weights to be adopted for the evaluation are as given in the attached sheets.
